<p>The aim is to install 10 Woodcrete bird nesting boxes with 32mm access holes suitable for tits, sparrows, nuthatches and similar birds. These have an anticipated life of 20-25 years and are easy to clean and also provide protection against predators. Daytime bat roosts are becoming scarcer and we also aim to install 6 large multichamber woodstone bat boxes.</p>

The wild bird population is diminishing rapidly for various reasons as are daytime bat roost sites. It is expected that the bird and bat boxes will assist in increasing the bird and bat populations within the park
